CYCLISTS

- Slow down! If speed matters to you please use other routes
- Please give priority to pedestrians.
- Warn of your approach with a bell or friendly voice
- Be prepared to slow down, stop and dismount

WALKING OR JOGGING

- Stay alert for passing cyclists
- On hearing a bicycle bell or cautionary voice:
 - Move to the side of the towpath
 - Allow cyclists to pass
- When joining the towpath give way to users already on it
- Big groups and those pushing buggies should make way for other towpath users to pass by
